Colonel Calvin L. Lane assumed the duties of Project Manager for the Utilities Helicopters Project Office on September 5, 2019. He previously served as the Project Director of PEO Aviation's Multi-National Aviation Special Project Office.

COL Lane is a native of Enterprise, Alabama. His military career began in 1990 when he enlisted in the Army as a UH-60 Helicopter Repairman. In 2000, he served with the 1st Armored Division in Hanau, Germany as Commander of Alpha Company, 1-501st Attack during Operation Iraqi Freedom. He also served at the Directorate of Combat Developments Fort Rucker, Alabama. His PEO Aviation assignments include Assistant Product Manager for Hunter Unmanned Aircraft System, PEO Executive Officer, and Department of the Army System Coordinator for the Joint Air to Ground Missile. In 2013, he served as the Product Director, Mission Support Aircraft for PM Fixed Wing, Product Manager, CH-47 Modernization (Chinook Block II).
