

U.S. Army Contracting Command Command Sergeant Major Jill L. Crosby

Command Sgt. Maj. Jill L. Crosby is the fifth Command Sergeant Major for the U.S. Army Contracting Command, Redstone Arsenal, AL. CSM Crosby serves as the ACC Commanding General's senior enlisted adviser on all enlisted matters, particularly in areas affecting Soldier training and quality of life. She assumed the position Aug. 10, 2018.

CSM Crosby entered the U.S. Army in February 1991 and completed Basic Training at Fort Jackson, SC, and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Lee, VA, as a 76P Materiel Control and Accounting Specialist. In 1994 her Military Occupational Specialty transitioned to a 92A Automated Logistical Specialist.
