

U.S. Army Contracting Command COL Mary O. Drayton Chief of Staff

COL Mary Drayton assumed responsibility as the Chief of Staff, U.S. Army Contracting Command, Redstone Arsenal, AL, in March 2021. She is the principal assistant to the commanding general for synchronizing the efforts of the headquarters staff in support of a 6,300 person command.

COL Drayton is a 1996 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York where she received a B. S. Degree in Life Sciences and was commissioned as a 2LT in the U.S. Army Chemical Corps. Her advanced civilian education includes a Master's in Business Administration from Regis University. She has a Master's in Strategic Studies from the Army War College, Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania.
