Selected for the Senior Executive Service in April 2008, John E. Hall became the HQDA Assistant Deputy Chief of Staff, G4 (Tier 3) responsible for Army logistics plans, policy and programs. In this role, he serves as the Army's leading Civilian expert and authority on logistics, managing a budget of over \$10B/year.

Prior to this assignment Mr. Hall served as the Deputy to the Commanding General, U.S. Army Combined Arms Support Command. As the Commanding General's Deputy, he was responsible for developing and integrating Army and Joint Sustainment capabilities, concepts and doctrine to enable Large Scale Ground Combat Operations in a Multi-Domain Environment.

From July 2011 to August 2015, he served as the President of Army Logistics University (ALU). He developed and conducted Logistics Professional Military Education for all Army Military Logistics leaders and trained and educated over 100,000 Logistics, ORSA, and Acquisition leaders from all services.
