Deputy Commanding General – OCONUS Operations

Colonel Robert J. Miceli assumed responsibility as the deputy commanding general OCONUS Operations (DCG-OO), U.S. Army Contracting Command, Redstone Arsenal, AL, in August 2021. As the DCG-OO, he is responsible for the training, manning and operations of six contracting support brigades, four contracting battalions, and eight contracting detachments that are aligned with Army service component commands comprised of more than 1,200 military and civilian personnel who execute over 40,000 contracts worth more than \$2B dollars annually. He provides strategic to tactical contract planning and expertise to support large scale Army and Joint military operations. He also serves as the senior contracting official for all OCONUS Army contracting brigades.



Prior to assuming responsibilities as the DCG-OO, Colonel Miceli served as the deputy director of contracting at U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, in Washington, D. C., from June 2019 - July 2021.

Colonel Miceli was commissioned as a second lieutenant of armor through the ROTC program at Gonzaga University in 1992, where he earned a bachelor's degree in history as a distinguished military graduate. He joined the Army Acquisition Corps in 2000.

His advanced education includes a Master of Arts in Management from Webster University and a Master's Certification for Program Management from Villanova University. Colonel Miceli's military education includes a Master of Science in National Security and Resource Strategy from the Dwight D. Eisenhower School at the National Defense University. He is a graduate of the Command and General Staff College.

Other key assignments include deputy program manager of the U.S. Army Small Business Innovation Research program, under Army Research Laboratories; Defense Intelligence Agency chief of contracting for the Iraq Survey Group; chief of contracting for the Communications Directorate, where he also executed space acquisitions for the National Reconnaissance Office; chief of acquisitions & technology directorate for the 401st Army Field Support Brigade in Afghanistan; brigade executive officer, 404th Army Field Support Brigade at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, WA; commander, 902nd Contingency Contracting Battalion; regional contracting commander in support of Marine Expeditionary Forces in Southern Helmand Province, Afghanistan; director for contingency contracting policy, Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army for Procurement; commander, Defense Contract Management Agency – Phoenix; chief of staff, United States Army Contracting Command.

His military awards and decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Meritorious Service Medal with six oak leaf clusters, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Joint Service Achievement Medal, the Army Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, and the Army Achievement Medal with one oak leaf cluster.

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
