Section A

Officer physical demands categories

3-1-1. General

This chapter provides the occupational physical assessment test (OPAT), allows the Army to screen applicants for their ability to succeed in their assigned specialty prior to entering active duty or active duty for training. Local commander are responsible for ensuring the OPAT is administered prior to approval of the soldier's reclassification, or branch transfer when applicable.

3-1-2. Specifications for enlisted physical demands

This chapter contains physical demands for each officer specialty. The chapter is organized by each specialty and defined as 3-XXX-1 where XXX represents the officer specialty. For example the physical demands for 13A, Field Artilleryman are located in section 3-13A-1. Additionally, a consolidate listing of the all enlisted categories is located in figure 3-1-1.

3-1-1. Officer OPAT Physical Demands Categories
