1. Residents are not permitted inside of the refrigeration units.
2. Food must be placed in a sealed, stackable (flat top and flat bottom) container such as a plastic storage bin, cooler, or cardboard box.
3. Containers must be labeled with name and phone number (either written directly on the container or on tape). Medication is allowed but labels must indicate there is medicine inside the container.
4. Food may be dropped off beginning at 7 a.m. on Aug. 27 and must be picked up no later than 7 p.m. on Aug. 28. Food left overnight on Aug. 27 will be locked, but pick-ups can be coordinated through the 29th BEB Staff Duty. Contact information will be posted at each refrigeration van.
5. Soldiers staffing the stations will begin reminder calls for food left behind at 6 p.m. on Aug. 28. Food items and storage containers remaining after 7 p.m. on Aug. 28 will be disposed of.
