Army Casualty Program – Civilian Coverage

- Army Civilians covered by Army Regulation 638-8, Casualty and Mortuary Affairs, Army Casualty Program
 - Department of the Army (DA) Civilian Appropriated Fund (APF) employees that die during travel status or TDY within the U.S.
 - DA Civilian APF employees & DoD Civilian employees in certain commands/agencies while assigned, deployed, or TDY OCONUS
- DA Civilian employees who become casualties as the result of hostile activity within the U.S.
- Non-appropriated Fund (NAF) Army civilian employees who become casualties outside the continental United States while assigned, deployed or TDY.
- Family members of DA Civilian APF/NAF employees residing with the employee stationed OCONUS or while in transit to or from the U.S.
- Army Civilians not covered by AR 638-8: All other Army Civilian employees




Army Civilians not covered by AR 638-8
