- SCO Submits DD2964 Sec Coop Education & TNG Team (SCET) Request to GCC J5/USASAC/SATMO
- DASA DE&C/USASAC Case Validation and Letter of Offer and Acceptance (LOA) with A&P
- SAT delivers capability to Partner

## SATMO History

Established in 1974 as the U.S. Army Institute for Military Assistance at the John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center, SATMO served as the Training and Doctrine Command executive agent for overseas security assistance training. SATMO reflagged under Army Materiel Command on Oct. 9, 2010 and became a subordinate command to the U.S. Army Security Assistance Command. Today, SATMO remains headquartered at Fort Bragg, N.C., the home of Airborne and Special Operations Forces. The brigade's Soldiers, Department of the Army Civilians, and Contractors are deployed to over 20 countries year-round to deliver Security Assistance Training in response to Allied and Partner training requirements and the six U.S. Geographic Combatant Commands.

# What is SATMO?

- A brigade-level formation which delivers 24/7/365 long-term embedded advising, instructing, and training to Allies & Partners across the spectrum of warfighting functions from tactical to strategic
- Organizes and trains tailored Security Assistance Teams (SAT) to meet Security Assistance mission requirements
- Deploys SATs worldwide in support of Allies & Partners and Geographic Combatant Command (GCC) Theater Strategies
- SATs capable of delivering full spectrum of Professional Military Education, Technical, and Advanced Specialized Training to meet specific Allied & Partners requirements
- Teams comprised of military personnel, Department of the Army Civilians and Contractors through in-house Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity contract
- Provides total package security assistance case management services and oversight
- Funded through DOD Title 22 Authority (FMS/FMF) or DOD's Building Partner Capacity Section 333
