The Contracting NCO provides operational and contingency contracting support to deployed forces and DoD agencies, and they manage, perform, and administer contracting functions for commodities, services, and construction using simplified acquisition procedures, negotiation, and other approved methods.

SSG: 8+ months rated time in a SFC position with subordinates*

MSG: 24+ months as NCOIC of a battalion or brigade staff*, and 6 or more months leadership experience in this position in a combat, operational (including Defense Support of Civil Authorities), or exercise environment
