


CMF 92 Progression Chart

At the advanced level, the Culinary NCO's major duties may include, ensuring that proper procedures, temperatures and time periods are adhered to during food preparation; directing safety, security and fire prevention procedures, management of personnel and perform supervisory and inspection functions.
