Dr. Diana M. Connolly became the Director for Policy, Resources and Analysis and the Chief Financial Officer at the Headquarters, Department of the Army, Chief Information Officer (CIO) on November 7, 2021. As the Director and Chief Financial Officer, Dr. Connolly is responsible the requisite vision, direction and technical advice relating to planning, programming, and budgeting for the Army's Command, Control, Communications and Computers and Information Technology (C4/IT) programs. Dr. Connolly oversees the Army's IT appropriations, totaling more than \$1 billion and drives IT management reform initiatives, including an annual execution of \$500 million for enterprise licenses, Army IT policy, business case analyses, implementation of enterprise services, and IT investment management.
