May training advisory for Army ranges on Oahu

SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii (May 1, 2023) — Local military units are scheduled to conduct various training activities in May that may be heard by surrounding communities.

Training can occur during daytime and nighttime hours and is subject to change based on weather and other environmental factors. Weather, such as overcast conditions can increase noise and vibrations. Should individuals hear noise, there is no immediate danger.

For the community's awareness, the training is as follows:

- May 1-4, 8-10, 19-20 Artillery/Mortar live fire training on Schofield Barracks
- May 1-5, 8-19 Blank fire training on East Range (Day Only)
- May 11 & 18 Helicopter training on East Range (Day Only)
- May 15-19 7 a.m.-5 p.m. Soldier Parking in Wahiawa Hts. at Lightning Academy. Leadership will brief Soldiers to be respectful of local neighbors near parking areas.
- May 29-30 Live Fire Demolitions Training on Schofield Barracks

The training above reflects the most current training schedules for the 25th Infantry Division, Lightning Academy and U.S. Army Hawaii. Other training can be scheduled in authorized training areas i.e. East Range, Makua Military Reservation and Kahuku Training Area. Unmanned Aircraft Systems, or UAS, training can occur 24 hours a day, seven days a week on Wheeler Army Airfield and in the restricted approved airspace over much of Schofield Barracks and a northwestern section of the Waianae mountain range. **Nearby communities may experience the UAS noise as well, including: Waialua, Haleiwa, Dillingham and Mokeleia.**

The military appreciates the understanding and continued support of the local community. While sometimes loud, this training is critical to ensure military units and service members are ready to accomplish their mission and return home safely.
