Lt. Gen. D. Scott McKean leads the development of future concepts, requirements and experimentation to support persistent Army modernization.

McKean is from San Jose, California, and commissioned into the Army as an armor officer upon graduation from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1990. During his Army career, he has led at every level from platoon through division command, including in Iraq and Korea.
