## COL Peter Glass, Deputy Director & Chief of Staff, FCC

Colonel Peter C. Glass was commissioned as an Infantry (IN) Officer from The Citadel. His first assignment was with 3rd IN Division (DIV) at Fort Stewart, GA. He served as a Rifle Platoon Leader, Battalion (BN) Adjutant, and Company (CO) Executive Officer (XO) in 3rd BN, 7th IN.

In 2001, COL Glass graduated from the Infantry Captains Career Course and subsequently assigned to XVIII Airborne Corps as an operations (OPS) officer and deployed to Afghanistan. COL Glass then branch transferred to Armor and was assigned to 3rd Brigade (BDE) Combat Team, 1st Cavalry (CAV) DIV 3rd BN, 8th CAV Regiment (REG) at Fort Hood, TX as an Assistant S-3.



After his staff time, he was assigned as the Commander of Charlie CO, 3rd BN, 8th CAV REG during OIF II. After his Command time, COL Glass was assigned to the National Training Center (NTC) as an Observer Controller, where he earned a Master Degree from Webster University in Management and Leadership.

In 2009, COL Glass graduated from the College of Naval Command and Staff at the Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island, earning a Masters of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies. He was then assigned to 1st BN, 68th Armor, 3rd BDE, 4th IN DIV, where he served as an XO and OPS Officer and then brigade as the BDE OPS Officer and then the BDE XO where he deployed in support of OIF, OND, and then Afghanistan as a Security Force Advisor Transition Team in the Operations Coordination Center-South in Kandahar. Following his time at Fort Carson, he performed as an instructor and later Assistant Professor, at the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, KS. COL Glass was then assigned as the BN Commander for 2nd BN, 7th IN REG at Fort Stewart, GA, where he deployed the BN in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve to both Spain and then Germany.

In 2017, COL Glass attended Senior Service College at the National War College, earning a Master's of Science in National Security Strategy and completed the Cyber Security Leadership Concentration Program from the College of Information and Cyberspace. In 2018 COL Glass was assigned to the Pentagon on the Joint Staff in the J5, Strategy, Plans and Policy in the Deputy Directorate – Asia, as the Deputy DIV Chief for China, Taiwan, and Mongolia.

Following his time on the Joint Staff in 2020, COL Glass was selected to command 316th Cavalry Brigade at Fort Moore, Ga. In 2022, following Brigade Command COL Glass served as the Executive Officer to the TRADOC Commanding General.
