Marie Dupont serves as the Logistics Modernization Program (LMP) Business Management Division chief. In this role, she oversees the LMP Product Management Office's (PMO) operations, contracts, business capabilities acquisition, and resource management teams.

Dupont oversees daily operations, promotes meaningful management strategies, and manages funding, contracts, priorities, schedules, personnel, and facilities. She leverages almost three decades of management and client relations experience to deliver requirements, meet deadlines, and create lasting relationships with her team and senior stakeholders, including the Army Materiel

She next spent several years as an advanced budget analyst for Tecolote Research Inc. and the U.S. Army Program Executive Office, Enterprise Information Systems in both Fort Monmouth, NJ, and Fort Belvoir, VA. Over the years, Dupont refined her expertise as a quantitative analyst and continued down the path toward management, as seen in her positions as resource manager for the U.S. Armament Research Development and Engineering Center, and as the acquisition analyst for the Combat Capabilities Development Command Armaments Center.
