# Chapter 8

Qualifications for and duties of specific warrant officer military occupations and grade standards for warrant officer positions

#### 8-1. General

This chapter provides qualifications for and duties of specific warrant officer military occupations and grade standards for warrant officer positions in authorization documents per policy established in AR 611-1.

## 8-2. Specifications for warrant officer military occupational codes

This chapter contains specifications for each of the occupational codes developed and approved for warrant officer classification. These specifications are to be used by classification officials, personnel managers, manpower managers, individual warrant officers, potential applicants for appointment, and their commanders, to determine in broad terms, the knowledge, skills and duties normally associated with each warrant officer occupation.

### 8-3. Performance standards

Each duty position is unique and each supervisor established performance standards which must be considered and met by individual warrant officers. Further, there is no intent to imply that each position which has been established and classified in a warrant officer MOS must contain all of the duties included in the following specifications. No attempt has been made in this pamphlet to include every skill requirement or duty performed within these occupations.

### 8-4. Standards of grade (SG)

Standards of grade do not authorize positions but provide a basis for determining equitable grades for positions after the number of positions authorized have been established under the provisions of AR 71-32 and 310-49. The tables in this chapter provide the authorized duty title abbreviations, standards of grade (SG) for tables of distribution and allowances (TDA) (8-XXXX-3), tables of organization and equipment (TOE) and modified TOE (MTOE) (8-XXXX-2) for each warrant officer occupational specialty.
