MEMORANDUM FOR Soldiers and Civilians of XVIII Airborne Corps and Fort Bragg

SUBJECT: Commanding General's Policy Letter #5: Dragon Family Time

1. Reference Implementation of Dragon Innovation Team Training (DITT) Serial 2202 Initiatives Control Number 22-05310933, PARA 3.B.1.A.

2. Leaders are responsible for strengthening resiliency, improving readiness, and promoting a culture of trust to build high performing organizations. To that end, Dragon Family Time is a Quality of Life program, intended to enhance Operational Readiness. It does so by providing predictability and time to our Soldiers and their Families to sustain high levels of personal readiness.

3. Commanders will ensure adherence across their formations to Dragon Family Time every Friday, from 1500-1700 hours. Commanders will plan activities to ensure they conclude prior to the 1500 start time for Dragon Family Time.

4. Exceptions to this policy must be approved in writing by the Commanding General, XVIII Airborne Corps.
