Command Sergeant Major Jason L. Gusman serves as the Command Sergeant Major of the U.S. Army Mission and Installation Contracting Command at Joint Base San Antonio-Fort Sam Houston, Texas. The MICC, a subordinate command to the U.S. Army Contracting Command, provides Army commands, installations and activities with responsive contracting solutions and oversight. On order, the command provides trained and deployable contracting Soldiers to the operating force. The MICC is made up of about 1,500 Soldiers and Civilian employees assigned to two contracting support brigades, two field directorates, 10 contracting battalions and offices across 30 locations within the continental United States.



Prior to assuming responsibility as the MICC command sergeant major, CSM Gusman served as the command sergeant major for the U.S. Army Garrison at Fort Detrick, Maryland.

He enlisted in the U.S. Army in July 1994 and attended Basic Combat Training at Fort Leonard Wood, MO, and Advanced Individual Training as a Unit Supply Specialist at Fort Lee (redesignated as Fort Gregg-Adams in 2023), Virginia. CSM Gusman's assignments include Alpha Battery, 6th Battalion, 29th Field Artillery (Multiple Launch Rocket System) at Strassburg Kaserne, Germany; Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (Airborne) at Fort Campbell, Kentucky; Joint Special Operations Command at Fort Bragg (redesignated as Fort Liberty in 2023), North Carolina; Headquarters Company U.S. Army at Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall, Virginia; U.S. Army Special Operations Aviation Command at Fort Bragg; and 528th Special Troops Battalion Special Operations (Airborne) at Fort Bragg.

He has held a variety of positions of increasing responsibility and leadership during his 28 years of service. Those include unit supply sergeant, battalion supply sergeant, logistics operations NCO, logistics operations NCO in charge, joint logistics operations NCO, joint support operations NCO in charge, first sergeant, logistics sergeant major, and battalion command sergeant major. CSM Gusman's operational assignments include deployments to Iraq, Afghanistan and the Horn of Africa.

CSM Gusman is a graduate of all levels of the NCO Professional Development System through the Nominative Leaders Course, First Sergeants Course, Battalion, Brigade, Garrison, Sustainment Pre-Command Courses and Command Sergeant Major Development Program, Action Officer Logistics Course, Joint Logistics Course, Support Operations Course, Battle Staff NCO Course, Special Operations Training Course, and Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape High Risk Course. He is pursuing a bachelor's degree through Excelsior College.

His awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Defense Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Joint Service Achievement Medal with one oak leaf cluster, National Defense Service Medal with one bronze service star, Afghanistan Campaign Medal with one bronze service star, and Iraqi Campaign Medal with three bronze service stars. He is authorized to wear the Combat Action Badge, Airborne Badge, Pathfinder Badge, Air Assault Badge, Driver's Badge and Army Staff Identification Badge. His foreign decorations include Australian, Columbian and Mexican jump wings. He is also an Order of Saint Martin recipient and a Distinguished Member of the Quartermaster Corps.

As of January 2024
