On Dec. 28, 2023, the Office of Special Trial Counsel (OSTC) became fully operational. OSTC exercises independent authority over certain crimes called covered offenses.



Victims are assisted through the legal process by the prosecution team, including Special Victim Liaisons. Every victim receives honest and open communication throughout every stage of the case.



13 Covered offenses include rape, sexual assault, homicide, domestic violence, stalking and most other sexual misconduct cases.


