This request may take up to 48 hours to be approved or denied. The Army News Service will prioritize requests bases on the availability of resources and scheduling.

The minimum expected time from approval to publication is 6 days for news stories and 12 days for feature stories.

If approved, the requestor will be responsible for the oversight of providing the necessary resources and support for content development.

Please read the process for ARNEWS coverage and acknowledge that you understand it by initialing in the space provided below the statement:

Process and a generic expected timeline:

- Assigned writer contacts requestor: 24 hours after request approved
- Writer research and coordination: 24-72 hours
- News story production: 24 hours after the interviews or event
- Feature story production: One week after the interviews or event
- Editor review and changes: 24 hours
- Review for accuracy and security by EACH subject matter expert or requestor: 24 hours
- Final edits and publication: 24 hours
