Mr. Cunningham began his career with the Department of Defense in 2014 as a Data Center Management intern for the National Security Agency. Shortly thereafter, he began his U.S. Air Force Civilian career as a defensive cyber operations systems engineer with the 33rd Network Warfare Squadron. He then assumed positions of increasing responsibility, including Chief of Operations Support for the Air Force Insider Threat Hub; Flight Director for Engineering and innovation for the 33rd Network Warfare Squadron; Chief Information Security

Officer and subordinate Authorizing Official for HQ Air Force Manpower and Personnel; Senior Civilian for the Attack Surface Management Center of Excellence; and most recently, Chief Information Officer for the U.S. Army Mission and Installation Contracting Command.

Mr. Cunningham's notable achievements include standing up the Air Force Insider Threat Hub User Activity Monitoring Capability; restructuring the 33rd Network Warfare Squadron into the Air Force Cyber Security Operation Center; redesigning the Air Force Security Suite to include the employment of SIEM and SOAR capabilities; and structuring the rollout of MDE across the Air Force Enterprise.
