Major (MAJ) Stephen F. Kirouac currently serves as the Product Lead for the Multi-Domain Artillery Cannon System within the Rapid Capabilities and Critical Technology Office (RCCTO).

MAJ Kirouac embarked on his military journey in 1992 by enlisting in the United States Army. After a distinguished four-year tenure, he transitioned to civilian life, undertaking roles as a Commercial Diver, Underwater Welder, and Certified Nondestructive Tester. Fueled by his unwavering commitment to service, MAJ Kirouac reenlisted into active duty in 2001.

Throughout his enlisted career, MAJ Kirouac held various operational roles, including deployments in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom; assignments within the Aviation Brigade, 3rd Infantry Division; Division Support Command 2nd Infantry Division; 2nd Battalion 39th Infantry Regiment, TRADOC, Fort Jackson, SC; and in the Army National Guard in 3rd Battalion 20th Special Forces Group (Airborne), Camp Blanding, FL.

MAJ Kirouac's transition to commissioned officer status in 2009 marked a pivotal moment in his career. He has since served with distinction in operational roles, including deployments in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan. His operational assignments include 325th Brigade Support Battalion, 25th Infantry Division; 782nd Brigade Support Battalion, 82nd Airborne Division; 188th Brigade Support Battalion, 18th Airborne CORP, Fort Liberty, NC.

His transition to the Army Acquisition Corps in 2016 ushered in a new phase of service, where he contributed significantly to various acquisition projects within the Program Executive Office Simulation, Training, and Instrumentation in Orlando, FL; Ground Applications Program Office in Fort Belvoir, VA; and the RCCTO in Redstone Arsenal, AL.

MAJ Kirouac holds a Commercial Divers Certification from The Ocean Corporation, a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with a minor in Military Science from the University of Central Florida, and a master's degree in Systems Acquisition Management from The Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California.

MAJ Kirouac has undergone rigorous military education, completing courses such as Airborne School, Transportation Basic Officer Leader Course, Logistics Captains Career Course, and Command and General Staff College, among others. Additionally, he holds several civilian professional certifications, including Level II ASNT and Yellow Belt Lean Six Sigma.

His exemplary service has been recognized with decorations including the Bronze Star, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, and Combat Action Badge, among others.
