Maj. Gen. William J. Prendergast IV is responsible for synchronizing Army National Guard priorities, policy guidance and resources within Army Futures Command and aligning Active Guard and Reserve efforts to support Army transformation.

Prendergast began his military career in Oregon, commissioning in 1994.
