Sergeant Major Kristie L. Brady assumed duties as the Deputy Chief of Staff G-6 Senior Enlisted Advisor in May 2024. The Deputy Chief of Staff G-6 is the principal military advisor to the Chief of Staff of the Army for planning, strategy, network architecture, and implementation of command, control, communications, cyber operations, and networks for worldwide Army operations.

Raised in Ethan, South Dakota, SGM Brady entered active duty in 1992 as an Information Systems Operator-Analyst (25B). She has a Bachelor of Science Degree in Computer Networking from Strayer University and a Master's Degree in Strategic Leadership from the University of Charleston, West Virginia.

During her 32 years of service, SGM Brady has served in a variety of command and staff positions to include Organizational Development Sergeant Major; Joint Communications Squadron Sergeant Major and J3 Operations Sergeant Major, Joint Communications Support Element; Communications-Electronics Command and Senior Mission Command

Sergeant Major; and multiple Commander's Initiatives Groups and Campaign Planning positions. SGM Brady most recently served as the Executive Officer to the Sergeant Major of the Army.

SGM Brady has held leadership positions at every echelon from squad leader to Command Sergeant Major, including significant assignments as First Sergeant, 228th Signal Company, 54th Signal Battalion (Kuwait); 63rd Signal Battalion (Fort Gordon, GA); 160th Signal Brigade (Iraq); Command Sergeant Major for 112th Signal Battalion, Special Operations, Airborne, 528th Sustainment Brigade, 1st Special Forces Command (Fort Bragg, NC); Brigade Command Sergeant Major for the Joint Communications Support Element, Airborne, Joint Enabling Capabilities Command, U.S. Transportation Command (MacDill AFB, FL); Command Sergeant Major for Army Communications-Electronics Command (Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD); Army Material Command (Redstone Arsenal, AL); and Headquarters, Department of the Army Staff, Sergeant Major of the Army office.
