Mr. Dunham served as an Aviation Assignments Officer at the Army Human Resources Command, Alexandria, VA and as the Department Chair and Professor of Military Science at Howard University in Washington, DC. During his final military assignment, prior to his retirement in 2017, Mr. Dunham served as the Chief of the Joint Operational War Plans Division on the Joint Staff, J5 in the Pentagon.
