Dn. Guerra came from Cuba on one of the first "Viaje De Libertad" (Freedom Flights) at the age of 6 and was raised in Southern California. Mr. Guerra was twice elected and served as Mayor for the City of Downey from 2006-2014. He also served as President of Independent Cities Association, representing 53 Cities and over 7 million people in the greater Los Angeles area. Dn. Guerra had the distinction of being the only Catholic Clergy to hold elected office in the country for 8 years. He currently serves as Chaplain of the Downey Police Department and is a member of the International Conference of Police Chaplains. He is the author of Embracing Change, An Immigrant Saga.

Mr. Guerra was ordained a member of the Catholic Clergy for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in 2002. He attended St. Johns Seminary College in Camarillo, California in the Diaconate Formation (1998-2002). He is also a lifetime member of the UCLA Alumni Association and has served on several educational committees at UCLA.

Mr. Guerra also served as President of Independent Cities Association and Executive Board member of Contract Cities Association.

He and his wife, Ann, are co-founders of Angel Tree for Downey. They also started the Diakonia Foundation which gives scholarships to local High School students for community service and outreach to others. He is a Deacon at the Cathedral of Our Lady in Los Angeles and St. Linus Catholic Church in Norwalk.

He was President and Co-Founder of one of the Top 100 largest insurance brokers in the country (Scanlon-Guerra-Burke Insurance) and is currently an executive with Arthur J. Gallagher Insurance, the 3rd largest in the world. He is a published author (Embracing Change; An Immigrants Sage) and a respected public policy speaker. He has been a guest lecturer and keynote speaker at Loyola Marymount University, USC, Azuza Pacific University, Cal State Dominguez and UCLA.
