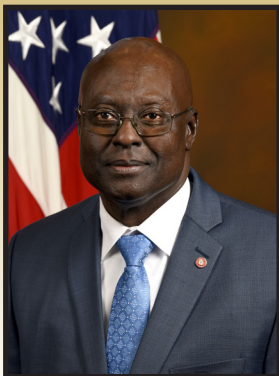

Mr. Beresford F. Edwards is president of the Virgin Islands National Guard Association and Chair Emeritus of the Virgin Islands Committee for the Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve.

EDUCATION

Mr. Edwards graduated from the St. Croix Central High School in St. Croix in 1975. He holds an Associate of Arts Degree from the University of the Virgin Islands (1996) and a Bachelor of Science Degree from Charter Oak State College in Connecticut (2001). Mr. Edwards completed the University of the Virgin Islands' Legal Assistant Certificate Program in 1984.

MILITARY SERVICE

Mr. Edwards completed Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Polk, Louisiana. In 1976, he was stationed at Fort Ord, California as an infantryman, followed by assignments at Camp Hovey, Korea, and Fort Stewart, Georgia. In 1979, Mr. Edwards enlisted in the Virgin Islands National, where he served over thirty-two years as a Military Police Officer. In 2009, Mr. Edwards deployed to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, where he served as the Deputy Director of the Commissions Support Group. On May 29, 2012, Mr. Edwards retired from military service after serving thirty-six years.
