

Mr. Iacocca entered the Army in 1988 through Lehigh University ROTC and served 29 years in the active Army. He served multiple tours in airborne and special operations units; highlights include Battalion Adjutant at 3rd Battalion, 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (ABN); Adjutant, 1st Special Forces Operational Detachment – Delta (ABN) and Command of the 82nd Paratrooper Support Battalion (ABN) and later the Special Troops Battalion, 508th Parachute Infantry Regiment (ABN). Mr. Iacocca's general officer assignments include Deputy Commanding General of United States Army Recruiting Command and The Adjutant General (TAG) of the Army at Human Resources Command. Mr. Iacocca retired in 2017 at the rank of Brigadier General.
