Mr. Ritchie, Minnesota's Secretary of State from 2007-2015, serves as President of Global Minnesota.

EDUCATION

MILITARY SERVICE

As Secretary of State, Mr. Ritchie served on the Senior Advisory Council for the Minnesota National Guard.

GOVERNMENT SERVICE

Mr. Ritchie was elected Secretary of State in November of 2006 and served until retiring from this position in 2015. In the 1980s, Mr. Ritchie served as the international trade policy analyst at the State of Minnesota's Department of Agriculture. He serves as an appointed member of the federal Election Assistance Commission Board of Advisors and was a member of the U.S. Trade Representative's Trade and Environmental Policy Advisory Committee and delegate to the World Trade Organization Founding Ministerial.
