The installation access control team implemented a vastly improved system for approving non-affiliated personnel access. The system uses online pre-vetting and provides significantly improved metrics and mass access control.



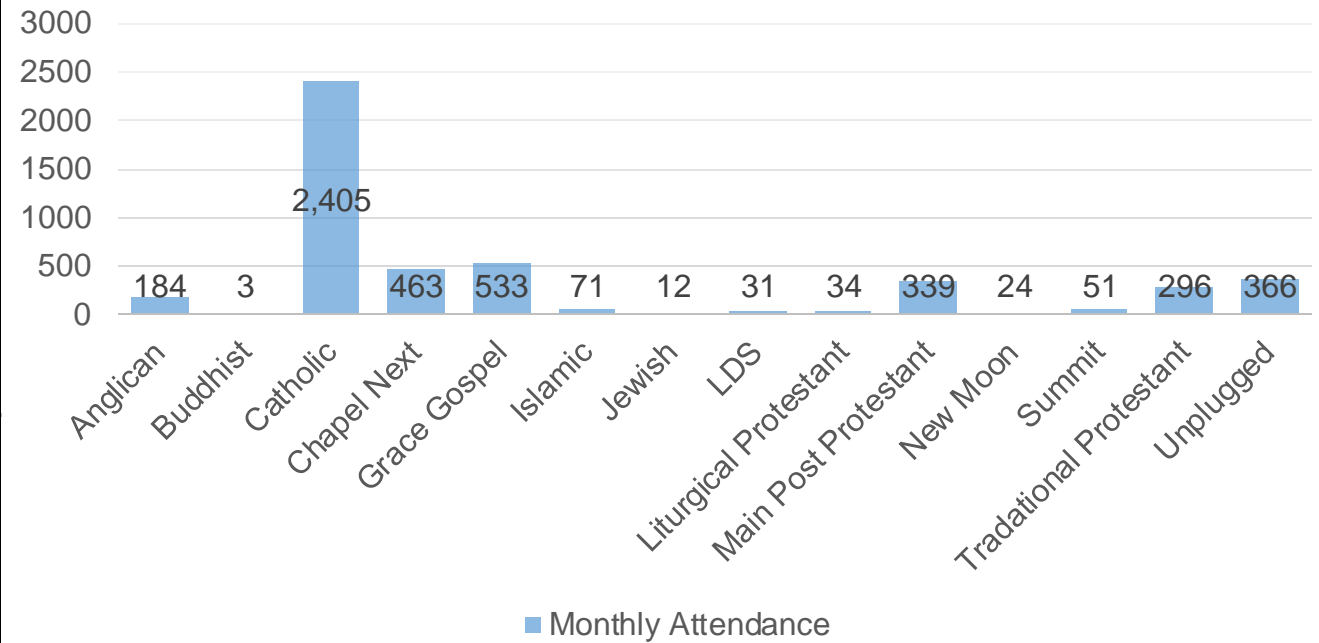

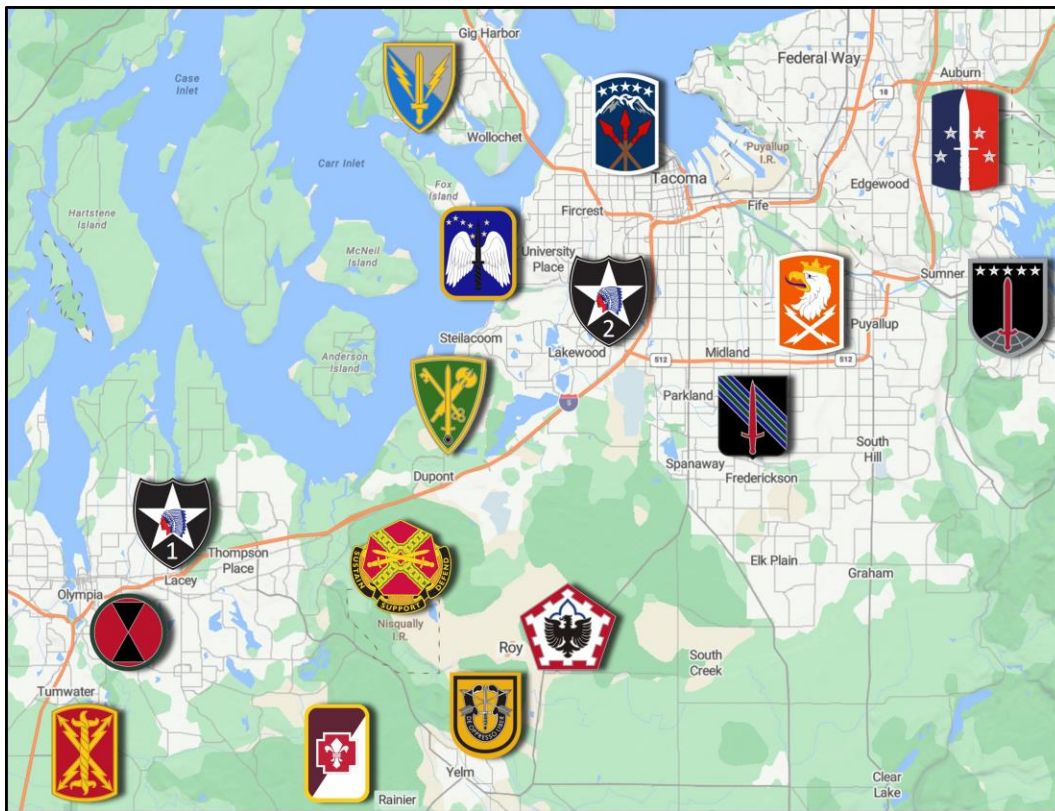

- Participants have limited, no military/AF knowledge
- Expanded outreach area, not limited to border communities
- Typically 20-25 Hon/CC at a time
- Participate in Wing/Unit on-base functions, events
- 2-year commitment – Devote reasonable amount of time to the program
- Opportunity for increased involvement at MAJCOM / AF level

- Increase bond between AF/Community
- Engage, educate, empower community leaders to be unofficial spokespersons
- Provide feedback on AF impact to local community
- Provide their perspective on Air Force initiatives, issues and other matters of interest

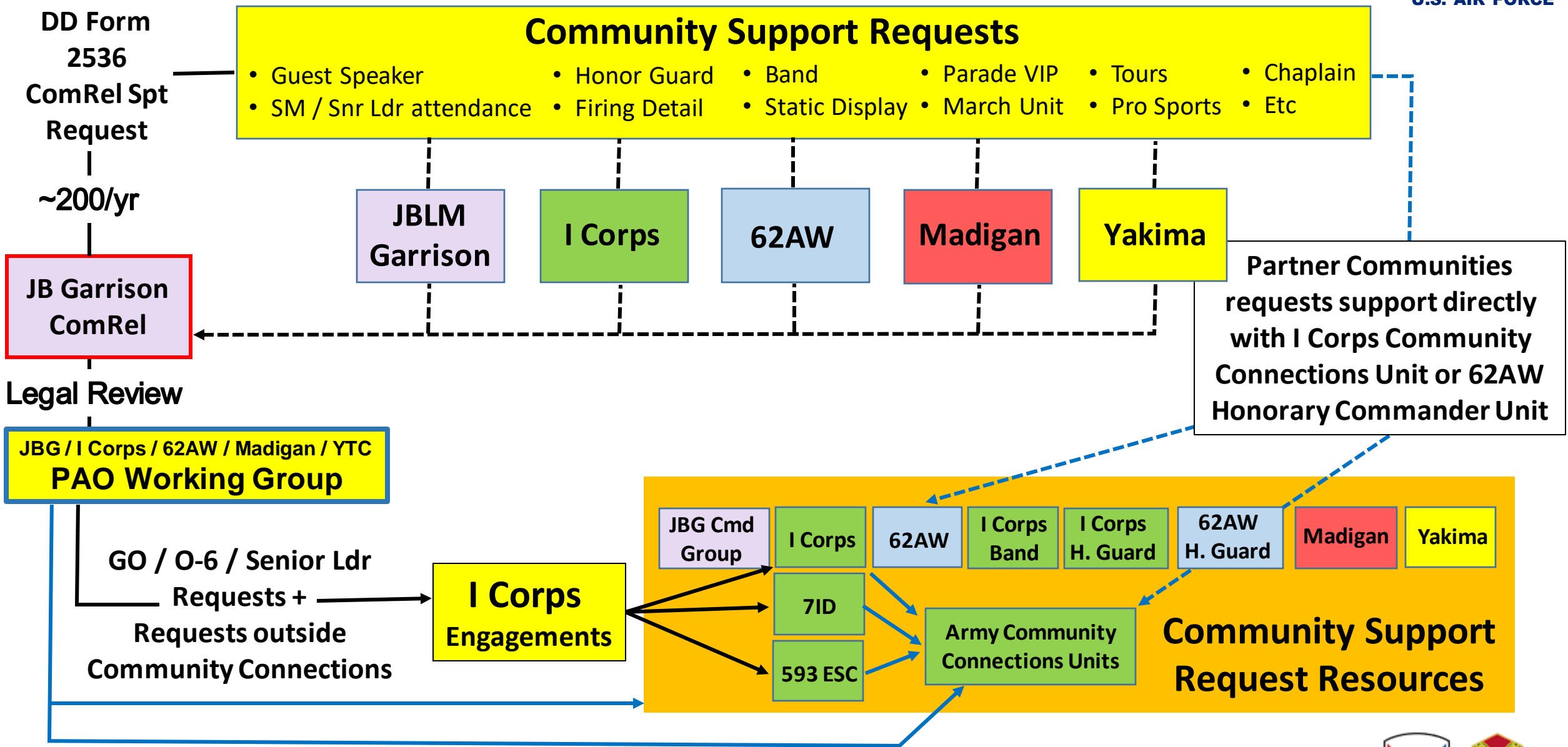
