Skills include performing Quality Control (QC) measures, inspecting, testing, and adjusting components to specific tolerances. Repairs unserviceable items by removing and replacing defective components and parts. Repairs unserviceable optical and infrared components by aligning, adjusting, removing and replacing defective modules and assemblies.
