SUBJECT: ACC Policy Letter #2 - Wear of the Military Police Brassard

- 1. Reference: AR 670-1, Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia, dated 3 February 2005.
- 2. Effective immediately, the MP Brassard will be worn by all ACC Military Police Soldiers while performing military police corrections duties. The intent of this policy is to standardize the wear of the MP Brassard across the command.
- 3. The Military Police Brassard is described as a rectangular shaped foliage green and embroidered device consisting of two black letters "MP", 1-11/32 inches in height, its overall dimensions are 1-13/16 inches in height by 2-7/8 inches in width, all within a 1/8 inch foliage green border. The brassard is hook-and-loop and will be attached to the uppermost portion of the left arm ACU pocket. The brassard will be issued to Soldiers through unit supply channels.
