Mr. John J Driscoll retired as a Brigadier General of the Massachusetts Army National Guard and sits on multiple boards, serves as a chair and strategic advisor in the private sector, speaks on leadership and Patriotism, and teaches as an adjunct professor of leadership.

EDUCATION

Mr Driscoll has a B.S. from Northeastern University, an M.A. from American Military University, and an M.A. in Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College, along with executive courses at Harvard University's JFK School of Government and Syracuse's Maxwell School for National Security Studies.

MILITARY SERVICE

Mr. Driscoll was commissioned as a Field Artillery on active duty and branched Infantry officer in the NG. He was deployed to Operation Desert Shield/Storm. He served as the MA ARNG Commander from 2018-2022 and as USCENTCOM CHOPS from 2017-2018. He commanded in every rank from LT to BG and, as Recruiting Commander, was nationally recognized nine times. His GO time was eventful with unit deployments and REFRADs, the COVID response, and civil unrest, he led the 27 state TF Capitol Grounds in Washington DC from JAN to May 2021 and retired in June 2022 with 33 years of service.
