MEMORANDUM FOR All Eighth Army Soldiers

SUBJECT: Eighth Army Command Policy Letter #5, Military Equal Opportunity, and Harassment 24 Hour Hotline

- 1. Reference: Army Regulation 600-20, Army Command Policy, 24 July 2020.
- 2. The 24/7 Eighth Army Military Equal Opportunity (MEO) and Harassment hotline telephone number must contain the following information in the greeting:

"Hello. You have reached the Eighth United States Army 24-hour Military Equal Opportunity and Harassment Hotline. If you are the victim of sexual assault or sexual harassment, please hang up and call the DoD Safe Helpline at 1–877–995–5247, or the USFK SHARP Hotline at DSN 763-5700. Our office is now closed. Please leave your name, call back number and a detailed message and a Military EO professional will return your call within 24 hours. You may also leave an anonymous message. Simply hang up when you are done."

- 3. When responding to MEO and Harassment phone calls, the responder will identify themselves, their position, and unit, followed by "how may I help you?"
- 4. The 8A Military Equal Opportunity program office shall periodically review all websites where the hotline information is provided to ensure accuracy.
- 5. Hotline Instructions:
 - a. For calls during duty ours (0900-1700, Monday-Friday): DSN 315-755-2535.
- b. For calls during non-duty hours (1700-0900, Monday thru Friday, and all day during weekends, holidays, and other days of no significant activity): 050-3355-2535.
