8-4-1. General

This chapter provides the occupational physical assessment test (OPAT), allows the Army to screen applicants for their ability to succeed in their assigned specialty prior to entering active duty or active duty for training. Local commander are responsible for ensuring the OPAT is administered prior to approval of the soldier's reclassification, or branch transfer when applicable.

8-4-2. Specifications for warrant officer physical demands

This chapter contains physical demands for each warrant officer specialty. The chapter is organized by each specialty and defined as 8-XXXX-1 where XXXX represents the warrant officer specialty. For example the physical demands for 131A, Field Artillery Targeting Technician are located in section 8-131A-1. Additionally, a consolidate listing of the all warrant officer categories is located in figure 8-4-1.
