



# LTC(P) RAYMOND YU

**DEPUTY DIRECTOR  
COUNTER-SMALL UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS  
RAPID CAPABILITIES AND CRITICAL TECHNOLOGIES OFFICE**

LTC(P) Raymond Yu currently leads the Counter-small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (C-sUAS) Acquisition and Technology Division, under the Rapid Capabilities and Critical Technologies Office (RCCTO), providing direct support to the Joint C-sUAS Office (JCO), a two-star directorate assigned to assess, identify, review, and endorse joint requirements and capabilities on countering the small UAS threat.

Following company command of Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC), 501st Military Intelligence Brigade, LTC(P) Yu accessed into the Army Acquisition Corps in 2009. His first acquisition assignment was at Program Executive Office Intelligence, Electronic Warfare and Sensors at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland as an Assistant Product Manager for Radars from September 2009 to April 2012. From April 2012 to June 2015, LTC(P) Yu was assigned to Joint Program Executive Office for Chemical and Biological Defense as an Assistant Product Manager for Reconnaissance and Platform Integration and Biological Detection Systems. From July 2015 to June 2017, LTC(P) Yu served as the 640th Contracting Team Leader, 411th Contracting Support Brigade (CSB) and Brigade Executive Officer, 411th CSB. Following this assignment, LTC(P) Yu served as a Department of the Army Systems Coordinator (DASC) for Air and Missile Defense programs. Following his DASC assignment, LTC(P) Yu served as a Financial Synchronization Officer in the Office of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army (Plans, Programs and Resources). After his Pentagon tour, LTC(P) Yu served as the Product Manager for Handheld, Manpack, and Small-Form-Fit Radios. LTC(P) Yu then returned to the Pentagon to serve as an Inspector General (IG) Team Chief. Following his IG assignment, LTC(P) Yu served as the Executive Officer to the Principal Deputy, Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics & Technology).



LTC(P) Yu holds a Bachelor of Science in Business Management degree from the United States Military Academy and a Master of Science in Engineering Management degree from Johns Hopkins University. He is a graduate of the Air Defense Artillery Officer Basic Course, Military Intelligence Captains Career Course, Counterintelligence Special Agent Course, CI/HUMINT Management Course, Army Acquisition Basic Course, Army Acquisition Intermediate Qualification Course, Army Command and General Staff Officer Course, Program Manager's Course, and the Army Inspector General Basic Course. LTC(P) Yu is a member of the Acquisition Corps and is Advanced Level (Level III) certified in Program Management.
