

Major General Clint E. Walker is a native of Magee, Mississippi, and was commissioned as a Quartermaster Officer following his completion of Officer Candidate School in 1988. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration from the University of Southern Mississippi, a Master of Business Administration degree from Jackson State University and a Master of Strategic Studies degree from the United States Army War College. He has completed additional executive education at the Harvard Kennedy School, Syracuse University and the University of North Carolina Kenan-Flagler Business School in subjects including Homeland Security, National and International Security, and Logistics and Technology. Major General Walker's command assignments include Commanding General, 184th Expeditionary Sustainment (ESC), Commander, 106th Brigade Support Battalion (BSB), and Commander, Company A, 106th Support Battalion.

His key staff assignments include service as an operations officer and executive officer at the battalion level, Support Operations Officer and Security, Plans and Operations Officer, 114th Area Support Group (ASG), Support Operations Officer, Chief of Staff, Operations Officer and Deputy Commander, 184th Expeditionary Sustainment Command (ESC), and Director, Joint Staff, Mississippi National Guard dual-hatted as Deputy Commanding General - Mobilization, Camp Shelby Mobilization Force Generation Installation, and most recently as the Deputy Director for Logistics Operations, J4, Joint Staff. He currently serves as a Special Assistant to the Director, Army National Guard, for Headquarters Department of the Army, G4 Matters.
