His stateside assignments include Fort Knox Kentucky, Fort Riley Kansas, Fort Johnson Louisiana, Fort Carson Colorado, Fort Bliss Texas, and Fort BraggNorth Carolina. He served overseas at Camp Casey, Korea, and Grafenwöhr, Germany. He joined the Security Force Assistance Command on 21 February 2025 as the Command Sergeant Major.
