Command Sergeant Major Timothy D. McGuire is a native of Elk Rapids Michigan. He enlisted into the United States Army in January of 1995 as an Airborne Satellite Communications Operator-Maintainer. He has served as Command Sergeant Major for the 7th Signal Command

(Theater) since September of 2022.

Previously, CSM McGuire served as Satellite Operator/Maintainer in the 319th Military Intelligence Battalion (A), Fort Bragg, NC; Shift Supervisor in the 509th Signal Battalion, Camp Darby, Italy; Team Chief in the 112th Signal Battalion (SO)(A), Fort Bragg, NC; Communications NCO and Training Course Sergeant Major in the USAOMS, Washington DC; Chief Signal NCO in the 593rd Expeditionary Sustainment Command, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, WA; Chief Signal NCO and Operations Sergeant Major in the 19th Expeditionary Sustainment Command, Daegu, South Korea; the Command Sergeant Major for the 39th Strategic Signal Battalion, Daumerie, Belgium; FORSCOM Senior Information Systems Chief (G-6 SGM), Fort Bragg, NC and the Command Sergeant Major for the Joint Communications Support Element, MacDill AFB, FL. CSM McGuire has deployed multiple times while attached to various Special Forces teams as well as the Joint Special Operations Command. His deployments have supported both combined and joint training operations as well as combat operations in locations throughout the world including South Korea, Kuwait, Iraq, the Philippines, and Ghana.

His military education includes: Airborne School, SOC Jumpmaster Course, Air Assault School, Pathfinder School, Military Free Fall School, Satellite Network Controller Course, the Joint Communications Unit Special Operations Radio Operator Course, Survival, Evade, Resist and Escape (SERE-High Risk) Course, JFK Special Warfare Basic Instructor and Small Group Instructor.
