MEMORANDUM OF INSTRUCTION

SUBJECT: Memorandum of Instruction (MOI) for Recon School of Standards.

1. PURPOSE: To establish shared understanding of the purpose and execution of training for the Recon School of Standards (RSS).
2. GENERAL: The purpose of the Recon School of Standards is to provide training time and resources dedicated to improving the performance of Patriot Recon Troopers who have demonstrated difficulty in understanding, maintaining, and enforcing appropriate unit standards and organizational policies. By deliberately providing time and resources for counseling and re-training, the Recon School of Standards provides Patriot Recon Leaders with an additional tool for maintaining professional standards, good order, and discipline in support of mission success and unit readiness.
3. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:
 - a. Assignment to the RSS is at the discretion of the Troop Commander or ISG.
 - b. Assignment to the RSS is based on sub-standard duty and professional performance. This substandard performance may include, but is not limited to Failure to report, unexcused or missed appointments, and Traffic violations, Failure to maintain uniform standards or poor personal hygiene, etc..
 - c. Assignment to RSS as a retraining tool may be utilized until the deficiency or performance is corrected. All RSS retraining will be developed and executed to directly address the substandard performance and the plan of action will be documented on a DA Form 4856.
 - d. RSS retraining sessions will occur at the first available opportunity at the conclusion of the duty week while respecting the value of trooper's family time. Typically, RSS training will occur on Saturday mornings for a period not to exceed 3 hours. If the deficiency or substandard performance cannot be addressed in this period, a subsequent RSS session will be executed at the next available opportunity.
 - e. The 1st Line supervisor will retrain Patriot Recon troopers assigned to RSS retraining and the Squad leader or next higher echelon of leadership will approve the re-training plan prior to execution.

- f. Respective platoon sergeant's will be present for accountability of their assigned personnel prior to beginning the RSS retraining session.
 - g. Troop 1SG's are assigned responsibility to lead and execute Recon School of Standards on a rotating basis and is aligned with the SQDN's senior leader barracks presence program.
