## 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) to Host Gander Memorial Ceremony

FORT CAMPBELL, Ky. – The U.S. Army's 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) and Fort Campbell community will honor the memory of the 248 Soldiers and eight crew members who tragically lost their lives in the crash of Arrow Air Flight 1285 on Dec. 12, 1985.

Col. James Stultz, commander, 2nd Mobile Brigade Combat Team, will preside over the ceremony at the Gander Memorial on Fort Campbell, Dec. 12 at 9:30 a.m. The event will include a wreath-laying ceremony, remarks and a moment of silence for the fallen.

The Gander Memorial Ceremony is a solemn event dedicated to preserving the memory of those who perished when their flight crashed in Gander, Newfoundland, Canada. The servicemembers were returning from a six-month deployment in Sinai Egypt. The tragic event is considered one of the deadliest peacetime military air disasters in history.

Members of the media and Fort Campbell community are invited to attend this solemn occasion. A separate ceremony is scheduled <u>Gander Memorial Park</u> in Hopkinsville, Ky., Dec. 12 at 12:00 p.m.
