## MILSUITE SUNSET INFORMATION

APRIL 2025



### BLUF:

To improve efficiency and prioritize missions, the Army will sunset the milSuite platform. The platform will become read-only on April 16, and will be obsolete on April 30, 2025. Organizations and users must manually export their data. For more information on exporting data, please visit the [milSuite](#) website.

### Background:

milSuite was launched in October 2009 as a secure, cloud-based platform for Department of Defense (DoD) personnel, military, civilians, and contractors to collaborate, share information, and connect with peers. The Army will no longer support milSuite as part of its network modernization efforts. As such, users must migrate their content off the platform by April 30, 2025 or lose access to their data.

The Army has a variety of alternative capabilities that users should explore to meet their work and collaboration requirements. Users are encouraged to attend [information workshops](#) being conducted on milSuite, every Thursday at 1300hrs EST until sunset, to learn about other modern platforms available and best ways to move their data.

- For training and milUniversity users, Army users should refer to the [Army Training Information System](#) (ATIS) to explore opportunities.



### Immediate Action:

milSuite will sunset on April 30, 2025. All data will be permanently unavailable after this date. Organizations and users that need to retain data on the platform must migrate their information by this date. This is a user-driven migration - no migration tools or services are available.
