Regiment Senior Medic, 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (Airborne), Fort Campbell, KY; he has also served as a Special Operations Combat Medic, Special Operations Flight Medic, Flight Medic Standardization Instructor, Battalion Senior Medic, and Medical Operations NCOIC. He deployed seven times in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, five times in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and once in support of Operation New Dawn.
