BG Urbi Lewis assumed duty as Deputy The Inspector General, on June 23, 2025.

She was previously the Director for Cybersecurity and the Headquarters Department of the Army Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) for the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) in Washington, D.C.

BG Lewis entered the United States Army as a Private in the Army Reserve. She later earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Computer Information Systems from Grambling State University. Recognized as a Distinguished Military Graduate, she was commissioned through the Reserve Officers' Training Corps as a Second Lieutenant in the Signal Corps. She holds a Juris Doctor from Atlanta's John Marshall Law School.
