Maj. Gen. Anthony McQueen will assume command of MEDCoE from Brig. Gen. Clinton Murray. Murray will go on to the Joint Surgeon's Office at the Pentagon, Washington, D.C. McQueen's most recent assignment was as the Deputy Surgeon General, Office of the Surgeon General, U.S. Army, Washington, D.C.

MEDCoE is a Center of Excellence under U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command trains and develops medical professionals through 257 courses with approximately 50,000 soldiers trained annually. MEDCoE also develops and integrates medical capabilities to enable the joint force to fight and win the Nation's wars.
