



**Brigadier General Sean F. Stinchon**  
**Commanding General**  
**United States Army Counterintelligence Command**

Brigadier General Sean F. Stinchon is a 1997 graduate of Stonehill College, Boston, Mass., where he received his commission as a second lieutenant in the infantry. He attended the Infantry Officer Basic Course, Mortar Leader Course and Ranger School at Fort Benning, GA and was then assigned to the 10th Mountain Division, Fort Drum, N.Y. While there he served as a Rifle Platoon Leader, Company Executive Officer and Mortar Platoon Leader in 2-14 Infantry Battalion.

BG Stinchon joined the Military Intelligence (MI) Corps, and attended the MI Captains Career Course and Counterintelligence Course at Fort Huachuca, AZ. In 2002 he served in the 25th Infantry Division, G2X, and deployed in support of SFOR 11, Task Force Eagle, Bosnia-Herzegovina. Afterwards, he served as the Infantry BN S2 for 1-14 IN BN and then took command of B Co 125 MI BN, 25th IN DIV in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom II. After Company Command, he served as the J2 investigative team leader for the Joint POW/MIA Accounting Command (JPAC) on Hickam AFB, Hawaii, where he deployed many times to Southeast Asia, Europe, and Iwo Jima in search of unaccounted for Service Members from past conflicts.

In 2008, BG Stinchon deployed to Iraq and served for 12 months as a combat advisor to the 5th Iraqi Army Division G2. Upon his return, BG Stinchon was assigned to the Defense Intelligence Agency where he worked as an Executive Officer and Branch Chief in the Joint Intelligence Task Force-Combating Terrorism. In June 2012, he was selected as the Battalion S3 for the Army Operations Security Detachment and then as the 902d MI Brigade S3 until July 2015. He commanded the 310th MI Battalion, 902d MI Group from 2015-2017.

BG Stinchon attended the National Defense University's College of Information and Cyberspace and graduated in June 2018. Following graduation, he was a Division Chief and served as the Deputy CJ2, Operation Freedom Sentinel, United States Forces – Afghanistan, Kabul, Afghanistan from July 2018-June 2019. Following this deployment, BG Stinchon was the commander of the National Ground Intelligence Center from July 2019 until July 2021 in Charlottesville, VA.

Following Brigade Command, he served in the Pentagon as the Foreign Intelligence Director for the HQDA G2 and as the XO to the HQDA G-3/5/7. Most recently, he served as the Director of the U.S. Army Strategy Support Element for the HQDA G-3/5/7.

BG Stinchon is a loving husband to his amazing wife Jennifer and proud father of six children.
