Subject: Announcing the Limited Release of the Automated Negotiated Shipment Processing Application in Global Freight Management (GFM)

Purpose: To inform Transportation Service Providers (TSPs) about the upcoming limited release of the Automated Negotiated Shipment Processing application, part of the Transportation Enhanced Access Management Services (TEAMS) suite in Global Freight Management (GFM), within the Automation Transportation Request (ATR) system.

Be Advised: This is a joint advisory from G3 Special Requirements and G6 Project Management Office-GFM, announcing the release of the new Automated Negotiated Shipment Processing application in late September 2024. This release will be for selected shipping activities listed below. Please monitor the Message of the Day in GFM for further release notifications.

Application Overview: The Automated Negotiated Shipment Processing application has been developed to automate and streamline the DD1085, negotiated solicitation request submission process. It supports the entire lifecycle of the negotiated solicitation process, including solicitation and negotiation for domestic tender rates from commercial industry. This application is designed to handle large volume movements, lanes without tender rates on file, shipments with unique requirements, and those not receiving carrier responses through other automated means (i.e., ATR and Electronic Spot Bid).

Action Required for TSPs:

1. **Opt-In:**

- Select "Yes" under "Level of Service" on your company profile in the Freight Carrier Registration Program (FCRP) for "Negotiated Solicitation for Volume Moves and Special Services Opt in."
- Add or verify the "Government Rep" name and email in the "Government Rep Email" field.

2. Request Access:

 After the release date, request access to the TEAMS GFM – ATR application to view solicitations and submit bid responses for the selected shipping activities.



Submission Process: Upon release, make every effort to provide bid responses for the selected shipping activities through the GFM-ATR-Negotiated Shipment Processing application.

Full Release Timeline:

The full release of the application to all DoD shipping activities is yet to be determined. Until then, existing processes for negotiated route orders will continue to be used.

Training: Carrier training will be provided during the first two weeks of the release, with sessions held in the morning and afternoon (dates and times to be announced). Follow-up training will be available through the regular GFM training schedule: once a month in Carrier Training I and II classes.
