Subject: Use of the Defense Transportation Tracking System (DTTS) services for Shipments of Arms, Ammunition and Explosives (AA&E) and Other Sensitive Materials (OSM)

Purpose: To inform Transportation Protective Service (TPS) motor carriers of the modification of CA-25-04-09/0018 directing when to share data with DTTS for shipment monitoring.

Be Advised: The Defense Transportation Tracking System Program Management Office (DTTS PMO) will only execute the Satellite Motor Surveillance (SNS) and Trailer Tracking Service (DCS) transportation protective services when the Transportation Protective Services are documented on a Department of Defense (DOD) issued Commercial Bill of Lading or a Bill of Lading issued by a commercial entity that is shipping cargo on behalf of the DOD as stipulated in the terms of the contract between the DOD and the commercial entity.

Guidance: SDDC requests all TPS motor carriers transporting AA&E and OSM to not activate data sharing with DTTS PMO for SNS and DCS unless the TPS are documented on the Bill of Lading given to the drivers of the truck. The Bill of Lading is required to document the following TPS to initiate data sharing with the DTTS PMO: Protective Security Service (PSS) or Dual Driver Protective Service (DDP), SNS and when applicable DCS. If these TPS are not documented on the Bill of Lading, the motor carrier shall not initiate data sharing with the DTTS PMO.
