CAPT Victor A. Cunningham serves as the Chief of Staff for the U.S. Army Transportation Command (ARTRANS), the Army Service Component Command to USTRANSCOM and a Major Subordinate Command to the Army Materiel Command. ARTRANS provides deployment and distribution capabilities to meet national objectives.

CAPT Cunningham is a native of Texas. He graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Criminology and Psychology from Auburn University in 2004, was commissioned from the Auburn NROTC program in 2004. Additional education includes a Master of Business Administration with emphasis in Supply Chain Management in 2015 from the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, CA, and Master of Arts in Defense and Strategic Studies in 2019 from the Naval War College in Newport, RI, with certificate from the Maritime Advanced Warfighting School (MAWS), Joint Professional Military Education-Level I and II.

STENNIS (CVN-74), N412 Spares and Readiness Officer for U.S. Fleet Forces Command (USFFC), Operational Logistics Planner for NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center and U.S. Seventh Fleet (C7F), Yokosuka, Japan where he was the Lead Operational Logistics planner for the western Pacific region of USINDOPACOM, directly supporting the Japan Maritime Self-Defense Force (JMSDF), Royal Australian Navy (RAN), Republic of Korea Navy (ROK-N) and regional Allies in coordinated logistics. NAVSUP Weapon Systems Support - Nuclear Reactors Supply Chain Management Directorate (N94), the USS RONALD REAGAN (CVN-76) as Principal Assistant for Services (PAS) and Material Officer (S-8), the USS RHODE ISLAND (SSBN-740) as the Supply Officer, Combined Security Transition Command – Afghanistan for Contract Management and Oversight, Multi-National Forces – Iraq as the DLA Advisory Team - Program Lead to the Iraqi Army Class IX repair depot.
